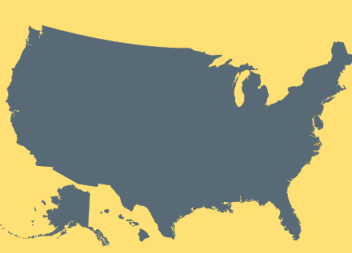

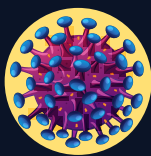

Nearly 37 million people are living with HIV worldwide, many of which do not know they are infected.



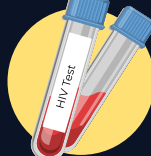
